His New Life

After being trafficked, you helped Kanoa heal and find the courage to tell you this amazing story. After a daring escape from the hands of his abusive captors, 15 year-old Kanoa has found healing thanks to you. Living in Laos, Kanoa has been on his own since he was just five years old. His father had disappeared, and his mother left for Thailand and never came home.

Somehow, this little boy survived until a family he trusted gave him a job on a fishing ship. "They lied to me. They told me it was a good workplace with a high salary. I believed them." For years, the crew treated Kanoa like an animal and threatened him with death should he ever try to leave. "Sometimes I thought of committing suicide and jumping into the water."

When the fishing ship docked to pick up more workers, Kanoa bravely took the chance to run. He spent 3 days in the jungle without any food or water. By God's grace, Kanoa found a helpful stranger that took him to a nearby World Concern safe house (that your gifts help support). Here, Kanoa is surrounded by people that love and care for him. He is learning new skills and is looking forward to starting his life again.

This is a heartbreaking story, but it has a joyful ending because of all that YOU have done for Kanoa, and other vulnerable children.

Noy is Safe, Thanks to You!

Like many kids growing up in poverty, Noy's parents could not afford to send her to school. Every day was a struggle for the family and as she grew older, Noy desperately wanted to help.

Unable to find any work in her poor Lao village, Noy crossed the border into Thailand to find work. This innocent 16 year-old was suddenly alone and incredibly vulnerable.

Noy soon found work in a factory,

where she endured 16-hour days under terrible conditions. In this dangerous environment, Noy was under the constant threat of being trafficked by men looking to take advantage of her.

"The work was very hard for me and I was always so tired," she says.

After almost a year, Noy returned home to her village. She still wanted to help her parents but did not have the skills to find a safe and well-paying job.

Thanks to you, Noy was able to find work and turn her life around!
